Goals are scored by players by putting the ball between two goal posts which is defended by the opposing team. Players move the ball by hitting with the head or kicking. People all over the world have played games which required carrying a ball or kicking it since ancient times. But, it is noteworthy that most of the modern codes of football originated in England. The term football referred to many games played on foot in medieval Europe. In 1586, men from a ship commanded by an English explorer named John Davis went ashore to play a game of football with Inuit (Eskimo) people in Greenland. In the medieval ages, there was a huge rise in the popularity of football throughout Europe. Such form of football was called 'mob football and it would be played in towns and villages involving unlimited number of players in opposing teams. The popularity of the game has ground with the passage of time and now the Soccer World Cup which is organised once in four years, is a global event.
