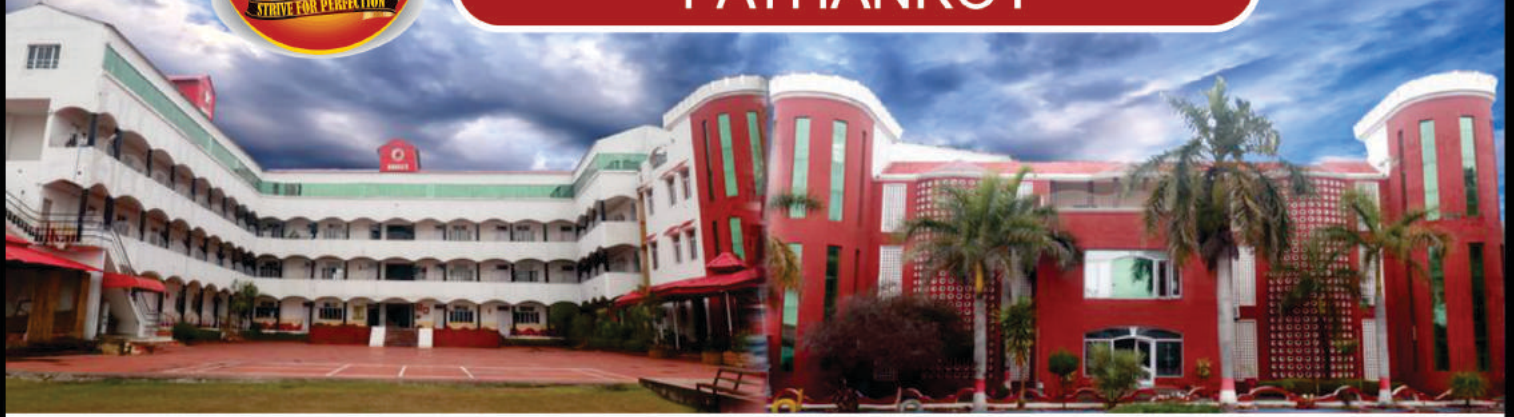

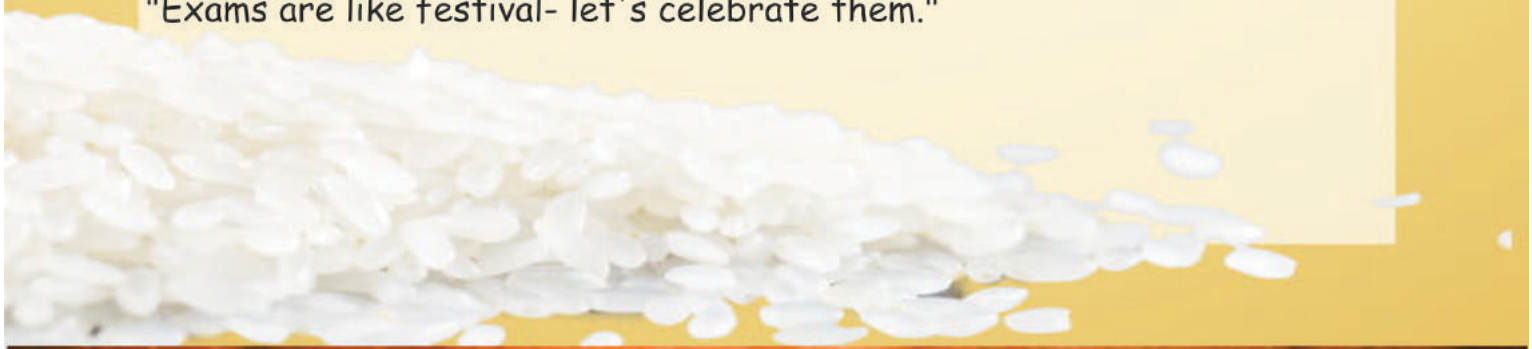
Exams - A challenge

Never respond to any kind of spam, if you do, it can lead to installation of malicious software.

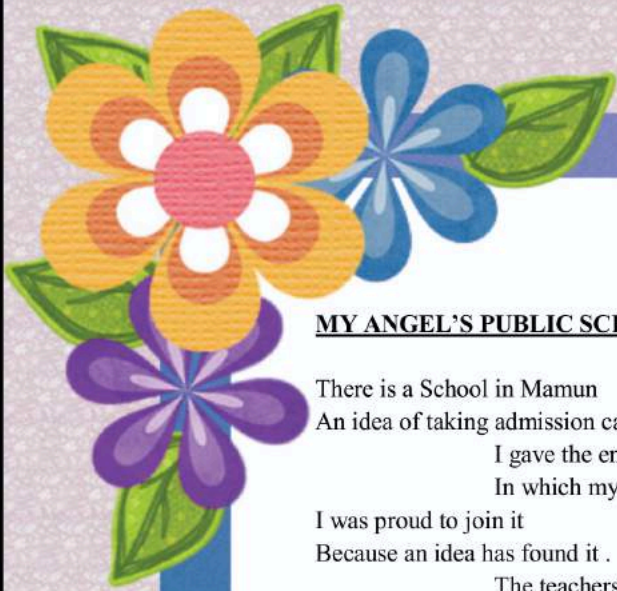
Avoid downloading any free software unless you are sure it's legitimate. Sites offering free screensavers, emoticons and smileys can also install malicious software into your system.
