President's Report

I am honored to serve as president of the Tacoma Sportsmen's Club for 2024. I would like to thank every member that came to the annual meeting and cast their ballot. This is a time-honored tradition of the club where we transfer leadership or reaffirm our support of current leaders who are willing to serve another term. We have a great board that is ready to continue the hard work that has been going on over the last several years.

We already have a work party planned for February 10th with another work party in the works in the coming months. Please reach out Scott Augustine at the house committee meeting the 3rd Tuesday of the month at 7 PM or contact the office if you would like to volunteer or have identified a project that needs to be done.

We are working hard to raise funds to acquire the 113 acres adjoining the club property to the south. The Tacoma Sportsmen's Club Conservation Land Foundation has gathered grants for most of the purchase. The Tacoma Sportsmen's Club's contribution for the purchase is \$650,000. We need to raise the money by the end of July this year. The property will be put into a conservation easement to create a buffer zone from businesses and residential housing/apartments. This purchase will also allow us to keep the public ranges, archery walk through, and 600-yard range. The club is having a benefit dinner and auction in February to raise funds for the land purchase with a potential second benefit dinner and auction in the next several months. I would like to ask that each member donate and/or help generate funds to the club with this purchase. The donations are tax deductible as the club is 501c3.

If you would like to know more of what is happening around the club, please come to our general membership meeting the first Wednesday of each month or come out to Tuesday social hour. The kitchen is open Tuesdays from 5 PM-7PM and the bar opens at 5 PM. This is a great opportunity to meet other people from the club and try your hand at cornhole.





Classes

<u>Hunter</u>: Factory semi auto and bolt actions and barrels with muzzle diameter of -750° or less. No scope restrictions.

<u>Varmint</u>: Factory actions and barrels with muzzle diameter of .930" or less. No scope restrictions.

<u>Custom</u>: Custom actions, barrels, and triggers. No benchrest stocks allowed, i.e., no stocks with flat bottom forends and buttstocks. No scope restrictions.

Benchrest: Custom actions, barrels, triggers, flat bottom forend and buttstocks. No scope restrictions. No weight limits.

<u>Tactical</u>: Custom actions barrels and triggers chassis with bipods only. No scope restrictions.

<u>Iron Sight</u>: No scopes or red dot sights. A shooter may only shoot a gun once, however more than one shooter may shoot the same gun.

Match Basics

Shooting will take place from bench. No prone shooting available at this time.

Competition consists of confirmation shot(s), unlimited sight in, and 10 record shots.

Record shots performed in five shot strings in 5 min with cool down period in between.

Monetary prize for shooter with the most center X.

Standard centerfire rifle calibers accepted, Non-standard calibers subject to review by committee chair and Chief RSO.
