

Classes

<u>Hunter</u>: Factory semi auto and bolt actions and barrels with muzzle diameter of -750° or less. No scope restrictions.

<u>Varmint</u>: Factory actions and barrels with muzzle diameter of .930" or less. No scope restrictions.

<u>Custom</u>: Custom actions, barrels, and triggers. No benchrest stocks allowed, i.e., no stocks with flat bottom forends and buttstocks. No scope restrictions.

<u>Benchrest</u>: Custom actions, barrels, triggers, flat bottom forend and buttstocks. No scope restrictions. No weight limits.

<u>Tactical</u>: Custom actions barrels and triggers chassis with bipods only. No scope restrictions.

<u>Iron Sight</u>: No scopes or red dot sights. A shooter may only shoot a gun once, however more than one shooter may shoot the same gun.

Match Basics

Shooting will take place from bench. No prone shooting available at this time.

Competition consists of confirmation shot(s), unlimited sight in, and 10 record shots.

Record shots performed in five shot strings in 5 min with cool down period in between.

Monetary prize for shooter with the most center X.

Standard centerfire rifle calibers accepted, Non-standard calibers subject to review by committee chair and Chief RSO.
