This time of year is a great time to get out and try your hand at Trap & Skeet, Sporting Clays, 600 yard shoot, Steel challenge, or Archery. If you are itching to get out for one of these events, check out the calendar for dates. Maybe it is just time to get out and shoot that new or old pistol or rifle. The pistol and rifle ranges are open daily.

We are a day away from the Benefit dinner to help raise funds to go towards the purchase of the 113 acres adjoining the club property to the south. The Tacoma Sportsmen's Club Conservation Land Foundation has gathered grants for most of the land purchase price. The Tacoma Sportsmen's Club has raised just over \$50,000 of the \$650,000 commitment to the TSCCLF for the purchase. I would like to ask that each member donate to help the club with this purchase. The donations are tax deductible as the club is 501c3.

If you would like to know more of what is happening around the club, please come to our general membership meeting the first Wednesday of each month or come out to Tuesday social night. The kitchen is open Tuesdays from 5-7PM and the bar opens at 5PM. This is a great opportunity to meet other people from the club and try your hand at cornhole.

I would like to thank Scott Augustine for organizing the work party on Feb 10 and the nearly 30 volunteers that came out to help, we got a lot accomplished. There is still much more to be done. So please reach out to the office if you would like to volunteer. With 20 volunteer hours per year you can reduce your annual dues to \$50. There's painting, repair work, cleanup, and much more that needs to be done.

Sporting clays needs volunteers for their monthly shoots. The bar can use more volunteers. For the bar you must get your WA MAST permit. Washington Online Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (MAST) (washingtonalcoholtraining.com) If you would like to volunteer as an RSO please reach out to the office and they can get you in touch with Mac, he can go over the details to get certified and volunteer requirements for going through the certification class.





Hunter: Factory semi auto and bolt actions and barrels with muzzle diameter of -750" or less. No scope restrictions.

Varmint: Factory actions and barrels with muzzle diameter of .930" or less. No scope restrictions.

Custom: Custom actions, barrels, and triggers. No benchrest stocks allowed, i.e., no stocks with flat bottom forends and buttstocks. No scope restrictions.

Benchrest: Custom actions, barrels, triggers, flat bottom forend and buttstocks. No scope restrictions. No weight limits.

Tactical: Custom actions barrels and triggers chassis with bipods only. No scope restrictions

Iron Sight: No scopes or red dot sights.

#### Match Basics

Shooting will take place from bench. No prone shooting available at this time.

Competition consists of confirmation shot(s), unlimited sight in, and 10 record shots.

Record shots performed in five shot strings in 5 min with cool down period in between.

Monetary prize for shooter with the closes center X. and smallest group.

Standard centerfire rifle calibers accepted, Non-standard calibers subject to review by committee chair and Chief RSO.

A shooter may only shoot a gun once, however more than one shooter may shoot the same gun.


We are getting ready to start up classes and hope that anyone that needs the class will sign up. The first class will be in April and then each month after that until September.
