In 2012 I will devote my articles to our Blessed Virgin Mary

Mary is our spiritual mother

Pope Pius IX from the dogma of the Immaculate Conception, in St Peter's Basilica declared: Ineffabilis Deus: From the beginning and before all ages,... PA STATE COUNCIL EDUCATIONAL LOAN PROGRAM

1. The applicant-student must be a resident of PA at the time of application.

2. The applicant must have attained the Knight-hood (3rd) Degree of the Order at least 6 months prior to the date of application and must be a member in good standing of a Pennsylvania Council, or

a. Be the son, daughter or wife of a member who had attained the Knighthood Degree at least six months prior to the date of application, and who is a member in good standing of a PA Council, or

b. Be a son, daughter or widow of a deceased member who had attained the Knighthood Degree prior to his death and who was a member in good standing at the time of his death

3. Loans will be granted for undergraduate study or for Nursing or Vocational Training. Loans will also be made for graduate Study. Part-time study may be approved. 4. Maximum amount of loan is: 1st year student will be \$2,625; 2nd year student will be \$3,500; 3rd, 4th or 5th year student undergraduate will be \$5,500 per grade level. Graduate Student will receive up to \$8,500 per

DUES / BILLING CHANGES

As most of you will have seen by now, the council has implemented a new billing system to collect dues from its members. This new system is an online system, owned by Supreme, which we have begun to utilize. The new bills consist of a remittance slip on the top 1/3 of the paper, with your billing information on the lower 2/3 of the bill. Using this new system will allow us to come more inline with the rest of the councils. However, as with most things that are new, I expect to encounter some growing pains. If you believe that your bill is in error, please contact me and we will work through the issue. Please remember that this billing is for a half year only. Under the new council bylaws, we are moving to billing on the fraternal year cycle. This means that you will receive a bill in the June – July 2012 timeframe and that bill will encompass the full fraternal year (July 2012 – June 2013).

I have asked for some information from all of you that will help us to populate some of the fields in Supreme's database. As stated on the lower half of your receipt, please submit your Email address, Phone # and Parish that you belong to on the back of your remittance slip. I would also ask that you include your next of kin information on the back of the remittance slip.

Finally, it is IMPERATIVE that you update me with any change of address that you may have. We spend a significant amount of money on return postage for mailings that do not get to some of our members because of an incorrect address. Please send me a note or give me a call at (215) 943-5865 in the event that you move to a new address so that we can update our records and you can continue to receive your K of C information.

Thanks to all of you for your cooperation and I look forward to continuing to serve our council.


