

CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

Fr. Edward Kelty

Father Kelty's message is a continuing reprise of excerpts from the writings of a religious Sister, Mary Ephrem (Mildred Neuzil, deceased 2000), from her cloister cell.

The next incident took place in the fall of the year 1954, when I was stationed at a different house of the Congregation. I do not remember the exact date, as I did not intend ever saying anything about it. I was sitting in the room next to the kitchen with the intention of saying some of my prayers. Almost at the very moment I began to pray, I saw an Angel. I knew this immediately, al-though the apparition did not reveal itself as such until later. I saw the Angel standing before me towards the left. He was dressed in a white robe or gar-ment, which was perfectly plain and perfectly white. The whiteness of his robe stood out against the darkness about him. It was like a light in the midst of darkness. He was holding a green palm and a drawn sword in his left hand, the tips of both palm and sword resting against his left shoulder. I saw all this at a glance. The Angel said to me, "Receive the palm discounted price they have initially of victory."
