Coats for Kids

With many families with young children continuing to struggle in these challenging economic times, there has never been a better time for Knights of Columbus councils to help by providing warm winter coats to children in their communities through the Order's Coats for Kids program.

During the 2012/13 winter season, 918 Knights of Columbus councils purchased and distributed 42,516 coats. This is a significant increase over the 2011/12 number of 31,528 coats purchased and distributed. Since 2009, the Knights of Columbus has distributed more than 115,000 coats to kids throughout the United States and Canada.

Chancellor Terry Hughes is currently spearheading our council's efforts to assist the Knight of Columbus with this endeavor. It is the first time that our council has participated in this program and Terry, along with his wife Liz, have collected enough donations to supply 144 needy children with coats! The coats are currently being shipped and we will be handing them out in the next few months. Stay tuned for the results....



The officers of the council recently discussed, and approved, a move that will hopefully lessen the cost of publishing and mailing the Vessel. Effective with the Vessel issue released for Jan-Feb, 2014, you will only receive the Vessel if you request that it be mailed to you. If you do not request that the Vessel be mailed to you via USPS, you will need to access it online at our website (www.kofc4215.com).

This will be the last Vessel that you will receive in the mail unless I have heard from you. Right now I have about 10 people that have requested the Vessel via US Mail. If we do not hear from you, we will assume you will be accessing the Vessel via our website.
