## Sophia Sunshine Delivers Literacy with Love!

Sophia is now sprinkling sunshine and kindness at Recovery Centers of America at Devon! Through literacy outreach, Sophia Sunshine is helping to bring joy and connectivity to the children visiting a parent during their inpatient recovery.

In my conversations with RCA staff, they expressed how visits after a parent being away from home can create a little anxiety and feelings of uncertainty (for both the parent and child), especially first visits. It's not uncommon for patients to express some nervousness and ask their counselors questions such as, "What do I



say?" Or "I'm not sure what I should do."

But the fun of picking-out and reading a good children's book together can be a very helpful ice-breaker. And that is the purpose of Sophia's bookcase in the library at RCA.

The purpose of the children's books are to help families reconnect at visits and be a gentle way to help children work through adversity. The story-time enables a parent to sit closely or snuggle up with their child(ren) and maybe make it the best 10 minutes of their day. The child is able to take the book home as a gift and look forward to the next visit together, the next story together.

The books help to deepen the love, strengthen the connection and help act as some of the building blocks to the skyscraper of memories and experiences that we build with our children each day. Your generously donated children's books truly have meaning and purpose.







