Dear Coaches,

Attached is a copy of the RGVSCA Scholarship Water Polo Application Form for 2024. Please give a copy of this form to seniors who meet the criteria listed below. The RGVSCA will award four scholarships of \$250.00 to 2 male and 2 females. The application must be received by the deadline of April 12, 2024 at 8 pm to yvonne.moran@hcisd.org. Applications that are not received by the deadline will not be considered. Applications will be reviewed and awarded by the RGVSCA Board Members. We will post and email awardees to all Coaches by April 26th. The athletes applying for the award must attend an institute of higher education Fall of '24 to receive the funds. If they do not attend in the Fall of 2024, the money MUST be returned to the RGVSCA.

Minimum Criteria: Athletes must have played two years of UIL Water Polo and also two years of varsity UIL Swimming or Diving. (Seasons: '22-'23 & '23-'24) Their coach must be a voting member of the RGVSCA. Their team must have participated in 2 RGVSCA Swim Meets during the '23 - '24 season.

Application: The application must be filled out in its entirety. The essay must be in MLA format (Typed, 12 font, Times Roman)

25% Paragraph
10% Academic Honors and GPA
10% Coach and Teacher Recommendations
