# KHC to change focus of spring trail ride

For the past several years, the Kansas Horse Council has hosted a spring trail ride on the Elk River Trail in SE Kansas near Independence. Because this Elk River Trail is a hiking trail, it has become increasingly more difficult to get approval from current Corps of Engineers lake management for equestrian access. Due to increased fees, restrictions, and conditions imposed by the Elk City Lake management, there will be no ride at Elk City for 2015. Putting on this Elk City Ride was definitely a team event, and we couldn't have done it without our dedicated crew of volunteers who came back to help year after year. From the pre-ride to mark and trim trail, to help with setup and registration, to being group leaders on the ride, then being among the last to leave on Sunday after making sure everything was cleaned up (including spreading manure and hay left behind by campers who 'forgot' to clean up their camp areas). We couldn't have done it without Randy & Jennifer Thomas Carnahan, Howard & Pam Banzet, Tim and Susan Searles, Bill Racy, Sam & Kathy Alloway Triebel and Pattie Stalder at the Kansas Horse Council! We had some good times and good memories!!

This is an opportunity to move the KHC spring ride in a new direction and to recognize the work being done to improve and expand public equestrian camps and trails across Kansas. So, plan to join the KHC at Rockhaven Horse Camp, Clinton Lake, near Lawrence on May 2 & 3. Diana Skinner and Ride Kansas have developed a partnership with park management that has led to full utility campsites, pipe corrals, a shelter house, and a shower house! Primitive campsites and a day parking lot are also available. The trails at Clinton Lake offer a variety of terrain through hardwood forest that range from rocky and steep to easier, more level footing. Dates for the ride are May 2 & 3 and a schedule is being developed that will offer rides of varying length and difficulty. Stop by the KHC booth at Equifest for


