 - Two horses needed
 - Must be gaited horses, over the age of 2 and broke to ride having issues with **TROTting**.

Saturday: Ag Hall Arena

- **1:45pm - 2:45pm; Trail Work - Get Your Spooky Horse to Act Like a Braveheart**
 - Two horses needed.
 - Any breed that is having an issue with **SPOOKING**.
 - Must be broke to ride, over the age of 2.

Saturday: Ag Hall Arena

- **2:45pm - 4:15pm; trail Work - Properly Preparing Your Horse for the Trail and Obstacles**
 - Three horses needed.
 - Any breed that is unsure of trail riding or obstacles.
 - Must be broke to ride and over the age of 2yrs.

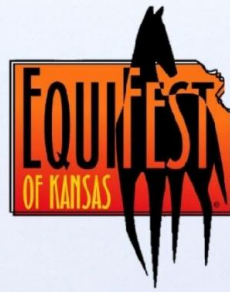
- **10:15am - 11:15am; Gaited Work - From Pace to Gait**
 - Two horses needed
 - Must be gaited horses, broke to ride over the age of 2 and having an issues with **PACING**.

- **11:00am - 12:00pm; Gaited Work - Getting a Balanced Gait**
 - Two horses needed
 - Any gaited breed that is having issues with **CONSISTENCY & STAYING in GAIT**
 - Must be broke to ride and over the age of 2yrs.

Here is what we are looking for!

Friday:

- **11:30 - 1:00pm; Groundwork into the Saddle**
 - Needing 2 horses - halter only; be at the arena ready to start 15 minutes before.
 - Perfect candidates: Pushy on the ground, walks over the rider/owner, and has no respect
- **3:00 - 4:30pm; Controlling Head Tossing and Stiffness**
 - Needing 2 riders - full tack; be at the arena ready to start 15 minutes before. **NO GREEN** horses. Must **SEND VIDEO** of horse being ridden without restraint.
 - Perfect Candidates: Usually ridden with a tie down or any head restricting gear. Horse that slings head when pressure is applied, pulls and roots at the bit or carries its nose in the air, lacks control, and has no collection.

Saturday:

- **11:30 - 1:00pm; Building the Riders Trust & Confidence in the Saddle**
 - Needing 2 Riders - full tack, Round pen will be used.
 - Perfect Candidates: Riders who have had a traumatic or terrifying experience with their horse. Each rider will get to work with Chris to help build their confidence back.
 - Rider must will able to walk, trot, and/or willing to lope.
 - **Send Video** - show rider and describe where they are lacking confidence. (Video does not have to include the lope)
- **3:00 - 4:30pm; Colt Starting**
 - Need 1 un-started 2yr old filly or gelding (no stallions!)
 - Cannot have been saddled yet. Halter broke and handled is preferred.
 - **Send video** of the horse in movement.

Sunday:

- **1:00-2:30pm; Using Dressage Principles for the Western Horse**
 - Needing two riders, one Western rider & one English rider, full tack; be at the arena ready to start 15 minutes before.
 - Riders will be learning techniques and exercises to help improve their skills. Please indicate your skill level in dressage.

An avid competitor, Mike was a World Championship Blacksmiths (WCB) Top Ten finisher in 2013, 2014, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021, the WCB Category 3 Champion in 2013 and a four-time WCB Match Play Champion from 2015 to 2018. He has also competed at the World Horseshoeing Classic several times, and achieved the goal of qualifying for the WCB team three consecutive years in addition to being striker of the year in 2020.

Since graduating from the Eastern School of Farrier Science in 1999 and studying in the Animal Sciences program at Virginia Tech University, Mike has shod horses in a dozen states on both the East and West coasts as well as in Great Britain and Canada. His clients include owners of performance and pleasure horses in multiple disciplines, as well as equestrian programs like the one at the University of Maryland, College Park, where he is a guest lecturer. His practice is based in Central Maryland and he has worked as a clinician for farriers and horse owners across the U.S. and Canada.

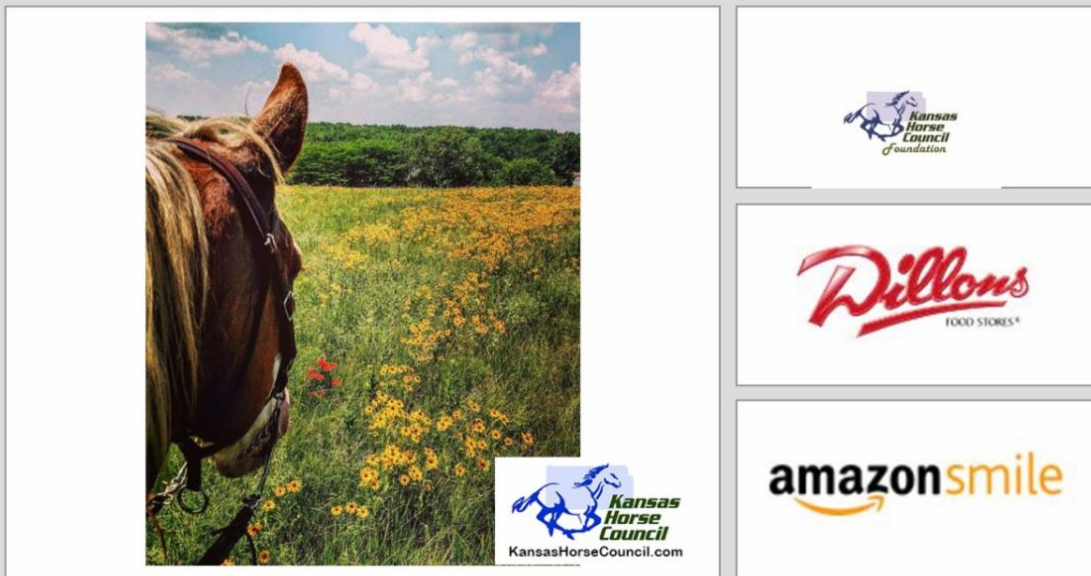

Earn rewards while working with your favorite equine friends! This program is open to anyone who enjoys working with horses, minis, donkeys, ponies, or mules, including "grade" equines.

This program recognizes participation in Equine Activities such as riding, schooling, competing, showing, training, ground work, driving, exercising, and assisting in a Therapy Program or Rescue. The program does not include feeding, stall cleaning and maintenance.

Awards are given at 25, 50, 100, 250, 500, 1000, 1500 & 2000 hour milestones. Upon 2000 hours completed, members are welcome to re-enroll and start again!

PROGRAM RULES & REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a current KHC Member.
- Must pay a \$35.00 initial program enrollment fee the first year and then a \$15.00 annual program fee thereafter.
- May ride or handle more than one horse and it is not necessary to be the owner of the horse.
- Hourly log sheets may be submitted monthly, quarterly or annually. Annual submissions must be postmarked no later than December 31st.
- The KHC Member participant will need an Individual membership to track member rewards by name.
- Rewards points are not retroactive. Date of log begins on enrollment date.
- Rewards are subject to change based on availability.
