HURRICANE SAFETY



MENTAL HEALTH

Mental health affects many people and by reducing the stigmas around receiving mental health, the world will be a better place. Check out these fast facts:

- 51% of females in the US receive mental health treatment
- 37.4% of males in the US receive mental health treatment
- 1 in 5 adults in the US experience mental illness every year
- 1 in 6 youth (6-1/yo) in the US experience a menta health disorder
