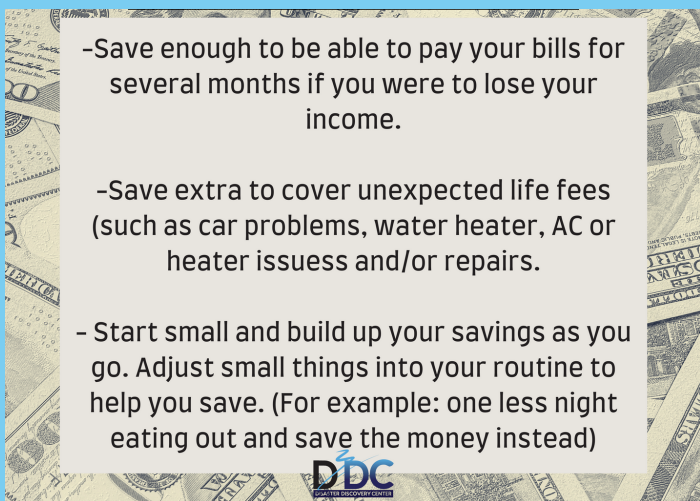

### INSURANCE DOCUMENTATION

Do you have your assets documented? Is your documentation up to date? Take some time this month to look at what needs to be updated. Take photos and video to show the state of your property. Document all damage, unique marks and serial numbers. Talk to your insurance agent and ask if there is anything specific they would recommend with your policy.

**Document Your Property**

- Take pictures of valuable property-include serial numbers, unique features (dents, scratches, stickers, etc)
- Take an annual video of your house - inside and out to document the state of the structure.
- Keep track of ownership documents - both paper copies and/or digital copies

### CAR ACCIDENT?

If you are involved in an accident, do you know what to do? If you read our social media posts this month, you should! Pull over to the side of the road or into a nearby parking lot. If you are unable to pull off the roadway or get to a parking lot, turn on your flashing hazard lights. This helps other drivers be aware of your presence and also helps emergency responders find you. Make sure you stay inside your vehicle and buckled up. This will keep you protected should you be involved in a secondary accident. Many of you may have seen the video that went the rounds on social media showing a vehicle ram another vehicle that had been pulled over by an Oklahoma trooper. This is how secondary accidents occur.
