1 . . . **Eliphaz the Temanite answered and said,**

12 Is not God in the height of heaven?

13 **And thou sayest, How doth God know? can he judge through the dark cloud?**

21 Acquaint now thyself with him, and be at peace: thereby good shall come unto thee.

26 **For then shalt thou have thy delight in the Almighty, and shalt lift up thy face unto God.**

27 Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows.

29 **When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save the humble person.**
