- 8 All things are full of labour; man cannot utter it: the  
eye is not satisfied with seeing, nor the ear filled with  
hearing.
- 9 **The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and  
that which is done is that which shall be done: and  
there is no new thing under the sun.**
- 14 I have seen all the works that are done under the sun;  
and, behold, all is vanity and vexation of spirit.
- 17 **And I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know  
madness and folly: I perceived that this also is vexa-  
tion of spirit.**
- 14 I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be for ever:  
nothing can be put to it, nor any thing taken from it:  
and God doeth it, that men should fear before him.
- 15 **That which hath been is now; and that which is to  
be hath already been; and God requireth that which  
is past.**
- 17 I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous and  
the wicked: for there is a time there for every purpose  
and for every work.
- 14 **For God shall bring every work into judgment, with  
every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it  
be evil.**
