- 2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:
- 3 **Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;**
- 4 Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;
- 22 **Bless the Lord, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless the Lord, O my soul.**
