Position Summary

Clients can receive case management services at home or in the community through Family Links. Among the services offered are accessing resources, finding employment and housing, parent-child education, life-work balance, and ensuring that the client is in compliance with DCS. In addition to providing supervised parenting time, case managers provide support and supervision to clients and their families. Caseworkers often attend in-person/virtual court sessions to discuss their cases and provide recommendations. Case Workers will prepare sessions and monthly reports using provider software and collaborate with other providers within and across agencies per DCS standards.

Position Responsibilities

- Conduct home visits as well as transport clients to goal-oriented appointments and court appearances
- Conduct family assessments, create treatment plans and behavior modifications within 30 days, and update your plans every 90 days with your client
- Schedule home visits according to the client's needs
- Facilitate supervised visitations and objectively report observations through a child's lens
- Provide time-sensitive, objective-focused services
- Provide parent education training
- Assist with community connections
- Use logical processing in helping clients
- Provide efficient and honest services
- Participate in staff meetings and in-service training as required
