## **General Range Rules**

## The following rules apply to all ranges

- Absolutely NO HANDLING OF FIRARMS WHEN UNDER THE INFLU-ENCE ALCOHOL/DRUGS.
- All firearms are to be cased, hoistered, <u>or with actions opened</u> with an <u>EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR IN PLACE</u>, magazines must be removed when moving to or from the firing line. Firearms are considered loaded when magazines are not removed.
- Please use your firearm's safety. Safeties should be on when not firing. No exceptions.
- 4. Eye and ear protection is mandatory on all ranges.
- Use only paper targets only and all targets must be placed on the designated target frames.
- DO NOT HANDLE FIREARMS WHEN PEOPLE ARE DOWN RANGE, (All
  firearms must be cleared. Slides back, magazines out, cylinders open,
  bolts open) AND A PUT AN EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR IN PLACE,
- 7. No automatic firing
- 8. No unsafe rapid firing.
- 9. No cross firing.
- You are responsible to insure all rounds fired impact the backstop, so make it a priority.
- 11. Your guests are your responsibility.
- ANY UNSAFE, DESTRUCTIVE HANDLING AND FIRING WILL BE REA-SON FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR DISMISAL.
- Any request for deviation from the rules or special functions must be made at the monthly meeting. (Third Monday of each month at 7:30 pm.)
