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

A sociopath can form relationships, but these are usually short-lived and not very deep or meaningful. They might try to mimic what a normal person would in certain situations, such as being nice when meeting someone's parents for the first time.

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

A person who scores high on the sociopath test could be sociopathic or psyc ${f O}$, sociopath test is most often used by psychiatrists and mental health pr


