

Dreams can come true

Since the founding of the ICC with a basement lease in a building on Acushnet Ave., the dream has always been to have our own building, a home to call our own that we could shape to suit our needs, enjoy and spread Italian culture and be financially stable. In 2005 we were dealt a heavy blow when we lost the lease, and were reduced to renting a tiny office on Maple St. with limited storage and no room to hold any meetings. Membership declined. Some thought our days were numbered. We searched for a suitable building to purchase as our own, but also wondered how we would finance it.

In 2008 we were able to purchase the former primary school at 56 Margaret St., with two loans: a large personal loan (interest free) given to us by an angel who wishes to remain anonymous, and the remaining balance financed by a mortgage loan, plus interest, to Mt. Carmel Church. This "patchwork" financing was certainly awkward and not the most desirable way to go, but was the only avenue we had, given our financial weakness. The logical goal was to repay both loans by wrapping them into one "normal" refinanced loan with a bank, at a favorable interest rate. However, before any bank would give us such a loan we had to demonstrate that we were a stable, growing and financially solvent organization.

That would not be easy. There were months when we had to wait until the end of the grace period before we had the money to pay the mortgage and utility bills. It took years of hard work, dedication and inspiration, but with our foundation now firmly beneath us, we created many new successful events, heightened the Italian presence in western Mass., and grew our membership substantially!

Finally we are financially solvent, and stable enough that a bank has agreed to give us a mortgage loan that consolidates both of the "old" loans into one loan, with a substantially lower interest rate than we were paying before. So, yes folks, dreams can come true if you believe they will, work hard and never give up. We have done what other ethnic cultural organizations have not been able to do – grow the membership and expand. We are now receiving calls from other organizations asking us how we did it, and how we created some of the benefits that we offer!

With your support and assistance the sky's the limit, but we need your help to continue the success. Please volunteer, and DREAM BIG!
