



BANDOLERO RULES

Updated 4/10/2024

The following rules will be in addition to the INEX Sanctioned rulebook for Bandolero classes:

1. Any communication devices, (Ex One and Two-Way Radios) will NOT be permitted in any competitive event. No signals of any sort by crew members, that can be determined to be a form of communication to the driver while on the racing surface during competition. If found in violation, the driver will be disqualified from the event.
2. Both Bandolero classes will be required to use 93 octane fuel to ONLY be purchased at the White Lake Gulf Station. 1490 State Route 17B, White Lake, NY 12786. No other fuel, or fuel purchased elsewhere, will be acceptable at any event for these cars or divisions.
3. Beginner Bandoleros will not compete with INEX Bandoleros unless moving up to the division. Once a Beginner Bandolero starts one points race (Heat or Feature), the driver cannot move back to Beginner Bandoleros, and is considered an INEX Bandolero requiring an INEX license.
