

## Dachenhausem Rolls Out Fifth Victory of Season in Asphalt Mods

Ed Dachenhausem has been on rails most of the 2022 season in his Nascar Asphalt Modified at Bethel Motor Speedway. When he has had a less than favorable week, he bounces right back usually the following week with the victory. Such was the case on Saturday.

Fred Nees and Steve Kammer would pace the Asphalt Modified field for the green with Dachenhausem shotgun on the field. Nees would gain the advantage, before Kammer was around on lap 3.

Dachenhausem found himself in the runner up position for the restart, taking the top spot from Nees on lap 6, and set sail for the checkers in the 20 lap main event. Kammer would rebound to second with Nees, John Cote, and Mac Crawson rounding out the top 5.

Since taking a mid-season break, Joel Murns has been a force to be dealt with in the Nascar Street Stock ranks. Murns returned 3 weeks ago, and has a 2<sup>nd</sup> and a win to his credit before Saturday's event. Scott Sepe and Chet Stanton would bring the field to green for the caution free 20 lap feature. Murns would make quick work of the front row on the initial circuit, with Stanton, Bill Deak Sr, and George Van Arsdall in tow. Deak would pass Stanton at the halfway point of the event, bringing Van Arsdall with him. The running order would remain unchanged for the duration of the feature with Murns going back to back wins with Deak, Van Arsdall, Stanton, and Sepe filling out the top 5.

Anyone who said racing is a guy's sport, hasn't met Pedersen's Checker Won INEX Legends driver Lexi Przybylinski. This young lady is out to make a statement, after winning her first ever feature on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, and repeating the following week. Chris Piasecki and Joe Przybylinski Sr would lead off the 20 lap event, with Lexi firing off 4<sup>th</sup>. Lexi would make her bid for the lead on lap 8, relegating Piasecki to 2<sup>nd</sup> with point leader Jack Polan moving to 3<sup>rd</sup> the same lap. Caution would fly on lap 18, bringing the field to a green-white-checkered, single file restart. Przybylinski Sr, and Polan would make contact on the final lap, but the green flag would remain out with Lexi Przybylinski taking her third win of the season with Piasecki, Joe Przybylinski Jr, with his best finish to date, Przybylinski Sr, and Polan the top 5.

Nick Foley would take home the checkers in both the held-over 4cyl Novice event, as well as the regularly scheduled event. Kevin Cargain would take win number 3 in the held-over 4cyl Truck event, with Emerson Cargain Jr taking the regularly scheduled event. Mike Travis would win both the Heldover and regular Modified 4cyl event.

Jerry Kingeter would take the checkers in the 4cyl Advance division. Leland Oefelein would take win number 8 for the season in INEX Bandolero competition, and Easton Houghtaling would chalk up another win in the Beginner Bandoleros.
