O.P.E.N

Focus: This initiative is to actively engage all of our assemblies in rigorous prayer for church growth and there will be a continuous publications of prayer bulletins.

STRATEGIES

Intercessory: Each assembly is encouraged to have an intercessory team and a fixed day and time for prayers every week

“Fire on the Altar:” Organize at least a 30 minutes prayer session before Sunday service

Mid-week: Organize mid-week congregational prayer meeting

3-days of Prayer and Fasting: Observe monthly 3-days of prayer and fasting of the church and encourage members to invite people

Quarterly Prayer Bulletin: Publish quarterly prayer bulletin to be sent out across the TACGV

Prayer Drive Thru: Organize periodic “Prayer Drive Thru” (Group of members will drive through the city while they pray in the car. They can also stop at specific junctions to pray over the land.)

Prayer Walk: Organize periodic (Members walk prayerfully through the streets and pray)

Prayer Chain: Organize “Chain Prayers” for major events in the church. Ex: The week leading up to family night events the church can alternate prayer one day of that week preceding the event (Various groups are assigned days/times to fast and pray for the event)

Open Air Prayer Crusades: Organize “Open Air Prayer Crusades” prayer events at the park or open space in the summer aimed at praying for the community

Prayer Vigils: Organize quarterly prayer vigils at the church to pray overnight.

Family Altar of Prayer: Members of the church should organize and use their “Family Altar of Prayer” to pray for the expansion of the work of God

Day of Prayer: Organize provincial or regional day of prayer for the expansion of God’s work in TACGV

Operation Matthew 18:20: Promote “Operation Matthew 18:20: Wherever two or three are gathered in my name, there I am in the midst of them.” Anytime members meet and greet new members and visitors they should pray with them no matter how short

Community Outreach Prayer: Pray for people during any community outreach program and minister to the guests

Prayer Decals: Create prayer decals and emblem with encouragement for prayers

Telephone Prayer Conference: Organize periodic “Telephone Prayer Conferences” as needed on Zonal, District and National levels

Point of Contact: Make it a practice to always pray over church materials such as tracts, flyers, gifts, emblems, etc. and use them as point of contact of God’s power to the people that will be receiving them.
