Boo's Belyeu



One of the world's most remarkable stories began March 3rd, 1887. Anne Sullivan begins teaching Helen Keller at age 6. While I'm sure most know this incredible story, just in case here it is. Helen Keller lost her sight and



hearing at 19 months due to a severe illness. She likewise could not speak. Helen was considered a bright, but spoiled and strong-willed child. As you can imagine the challenge to teach a stubborn, spoiled child, who could not hear, see, or speak seemed impossible. When Anne Sullivan broke through teaching Helen, she was dubbed "the miracle worker."

Jesus tells John's disciples these words in Luke 7:22 "And he answered them, "Go and tell John what you have seen and heard: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, the poor have good news preached to them." Jesus did all this and more. Recorded in John 9:9 "Jesus said, "For judgment I came into this world, that those who do not see may see, and those who see may become blind." More important than the physical is the incredible sight Jesus gives us spiritually. Acts 2:38 "And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

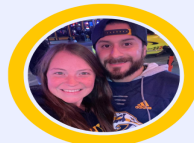
