

Folimary 29 Leap Day





This is a "leap year." You know what a "leap year" is we get an extra day 366 days in 2024 instead of 365. A "leap year" occurs every 4th year in the Gregorian calendar. The leap day is necessary to keep our calendar/year on tract. If we did not adjust by using a "leap day" every 4th year we would gain 5 hours, 48 minutest, and 56 seconds each year, thus over time changing the seasons.
