## KNOW YOUR BIBLE



This is a "leap year." You know what a "leap year" is we get an extra day 366 days in 2024 instead of 365 . A "leap year" occurs every $4^{\text {th }}$ year in the Gregorian calendar. The leap day is necessary to keep our calendar/year on tract. If we did not adjust by using a "leap day" every $4^{\text {th }}$ year we would gain 5 hours, 48 minutest, and 56 seconds each year, thus over time changing the seasons. I would tell you more, but my head exploded trying to read about it. Hey, on the bright side babies born on a "leap day" February $29^{\text {th }}$ don't age like the rest of us for instance my daughter in-law Kayla Spears turns 10 this February $29^{\text {th }} 2024$.
What will you do with your extra day this year? Psalms 39:4 "O LORD, make me know my end and what is the measure of my days; let me know how fleeting I am!"
