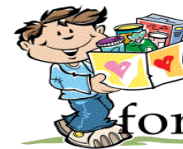

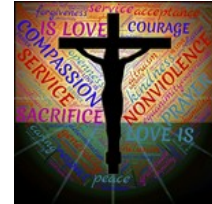

This week in history has some notable events related to the Civil Rights Movement. On March 20th 1965 President Johnson sent National Guard troops to Montgomery Alabama to protect Civil Rights Marchers. This was on the heels of what we refer to in America as “Bloody Sunday,” when on March 7th 600 marchers were attacked putting 58 in the hospital in Selma Alabama. The march covered 54 miles from Selma to Montgomery taking 5 days. The term “Civil Rights” means the rights of citizens to political and social freedom and equality. There is in Christianity a freedom that cannot be matched. Freedom from sin John 8:34-36 “³⁴ Jesus answered them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. ³⁵ The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. ³⁶ So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.” Isn’t it great we have freedom from sin as a Christian in Jesus Christ?
