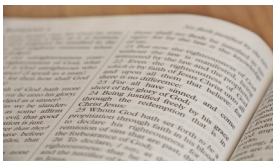


Boo's Belyeu



March 24th 1989 one of the worst oil spills in U.S. history took place. The Exxon Valdez supertanker spilt an estimated 11 million gallons of oil in southern Alaska. Attempts to contain the spill were unsuccessful polluting more than 700 miles of coastline. Have you ever thought your life was in such a mess you just can't clean it up? Sin has a way of making us think we can never overcome it much like the oil spill we mentioned. It seems an impossible task, yet with Jesus Christ it is not. ^{1st} John 1:7-9 "7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. ⁸ If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Note verse 9 we must have Jesus. Thinking we can do it on our own

will never clean up the sin,
but with Jesus he cleanses
