

Timeline of the Settlement of De Luz, Census 1900 - 1950 and the 1976 Directory of De Luz Residents



In the vast expanse of what is now known as California, the Luiseño Native Americans roamed the land, living off the bounties of nature. But their way of life was soon to be disrupted. In 1769, Spanish explorers and settlers arrived in San Diego, laying the foundation for a new era of colonization.

As the years passed, the Spanish granted vast tracts of land to various individuals, including the Mission San Luis Rey in 1798, the Rancho Santa Margarita y Las Flores in 1841, and the Santa Rosa Rancho and Monserate Rancho in 1846. But these land grants were not without controversy.

No accurate surveys were made by the Spanish owning these lands, and a large wedge of territory from the Fallbrook district to Rainbow and De Luz was left outside of the grants. After the Mexican-American war, this area was settled mostly by homesteaders, squatters, or claim jumpers.

A Spanish vaquero named Jose De Luz had a corral for his stock near the property that Orlando Stewart homesteaded. This was probably the source of the name De Luz. Basque shepherds also grazed sheep in the area but made no permanent dwelling or claim to the land.

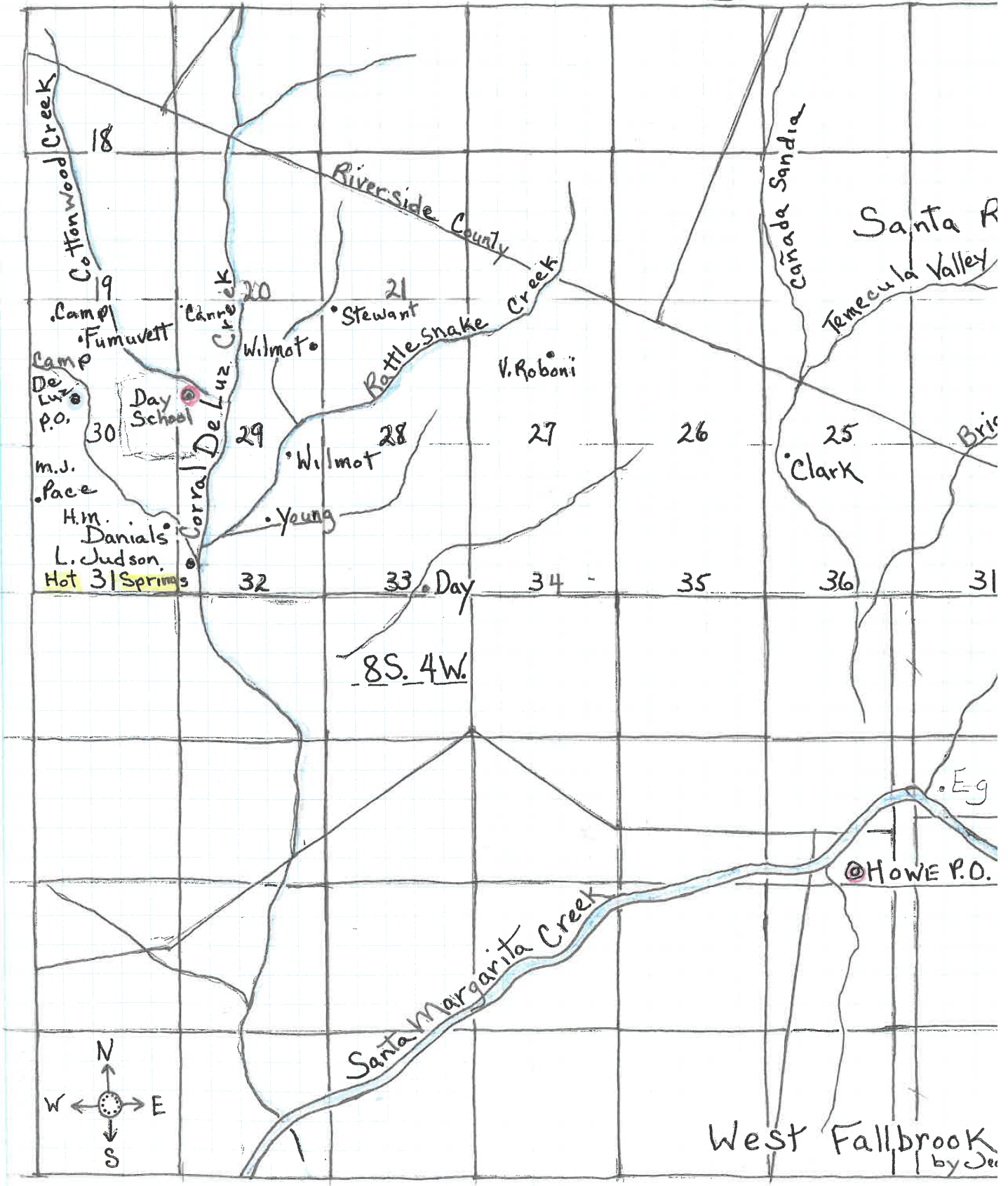
In 1861, a man named Mr. Spring squatted on land near Fern Creek and the warm springs. By 1881, Lemon Judson had built a four-bedroom house near the warm mineral springs. But it wasn't until the late 1800s that the area saw a surge in land applications.

In 1874, Orlando Stewart applied for land in Section 32, Township 10, Range 4. In the following years, others followed suit, including W. W. Wilmot, R. J. Wilmot, W. N. Moeller, J. R. Marsh, and Harry M. Daniels.

Rev. Henry J. Camp also applied for land in 1889, as did Charles E. Rubottom, Carr, Young, and Fumvelt. Vincent Roboni and Harry K. Day followed suit in the early 1890s, as did Mary Jane Pace, Charles A. Dicey, William H. Wisecarver, and Joseph Orvis.

Through the years, the land in and around De Luz changed hands countless times, as settlers sought to make their mark on the region. But the story of De Luz is not just one of land ownership and applications. It is a tale of the pioneers who carved out a life in this rugged corner of California, overcoming adversity and uncertainty to forge a new future for themselves and their families.

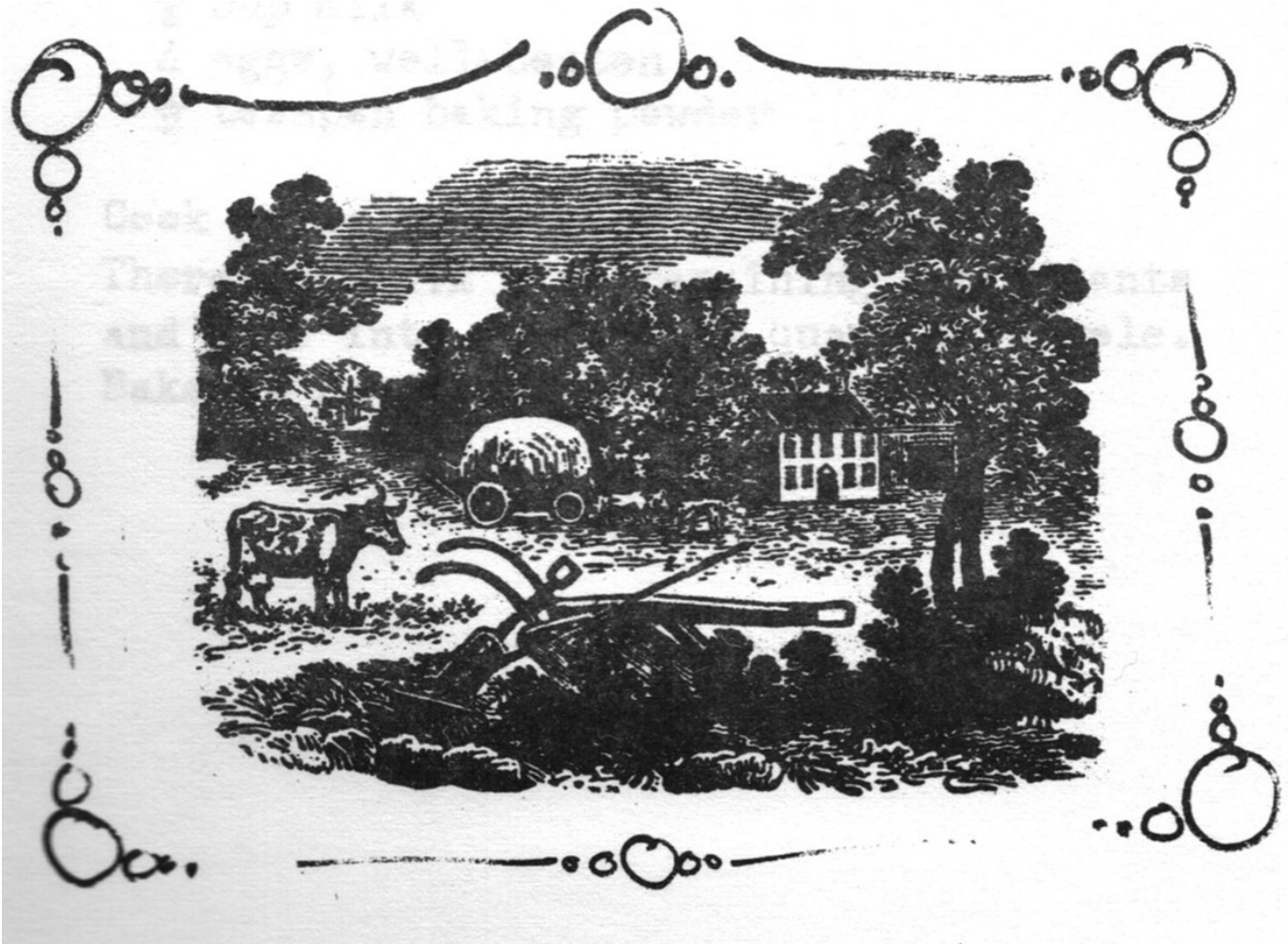

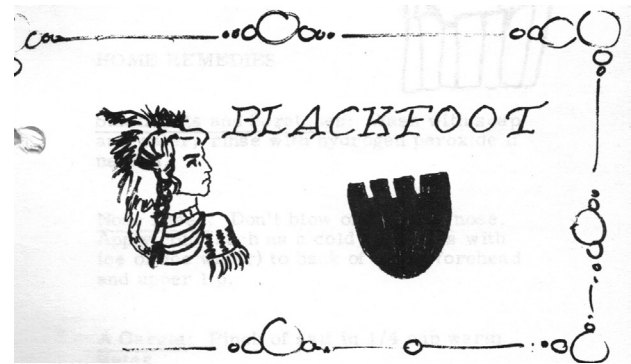

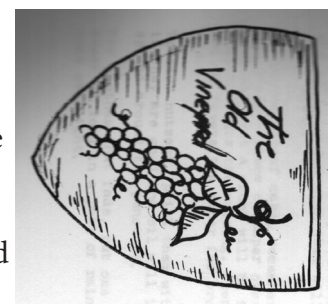
