

DE LUZ AGAINST DIVISION.

**A Strong Protest Entered by the People
of the Valley.**

On Wednesday afternoon the people of De Luz held a public meeting to take some action towards defeating county division on the lines laid down at the Perris convention. There was a large attendance and great interest was manifested. The people of the valley trade exclusively with San Diego, and it would put them to immense inconvenience to have to go to San Jacinto or Elsinore on county business. As the only idea of including De Luz in the proposed division is the strengthening of the chances of Elsinore's securing the county seat, the people of De Luz feel very sore about the matter. The following protest was drawn up at Wednesday's meeting and is now being extensively signed: That "we, the undersigned residents south of the Santa Rosa mountains and within the lines of the proposed new county, hereby enter our emphatic protest against being included within the proposed new county. It is our wish and determination to remain a part of San Diego county. Geographically, commercially and socially we are connected with the people south of us, and not at all with the people north of us, from whom we are separated by the mountains. For this reason, if for no other, we feel that it is for our best interests to remain in the old county."
