# **Utility S**

The Fallbrook Public Utility District yesterday was sued in Superior Court for \$60,000 damages for injuries allegedly suffered by a girl in a dynamite cap explosion.

The suit was brought on behalf of Judith Perinich, 13, by her parents, Paul and Nancy Perinich. They allege the district was negligent in allowing dynamite caps to lie loose in a house known as the Howard Harrison place adjoining the Perinich home in DeLuz Canyon.

Children were accustomed to using the Harrison place as a playground, the suit alleges. It said Judith picked up a loose dynamite cap the morning of Aug. 3, 1956. The cap exploded when in her hand that evening, causing permanent deformity of the left hand, the complaint says.
