### Spread Into Mountains

Still burning furiously in rugged terrain was the San Diego-Riverside county fire which broke out Friday near De Luz and has since charred 50,000 acres. This blaze was being fought by hundreds of marines, under Riverside state forestry rangers. For a time it threatened the Riverside county town of Temecula, where backfiring and a "providential" change of wind helped avert property damage.

Most of the San Diego county portion of this fire was surrounded by control lines, but flames continued to eat through brush and grass in the northern sector, and
