CAUSED BRUSH FIRE, IS VERDICT OF JURY

Frank Stoner of Oceanside was found guilty yesterday of negligence in care of a fire, which he is said to have started at De Luz canyon Oct. 1, and which burned over 3000 acres of brush land before brought under control. Stoner was tried before Judge Charles L. Berry at Oceanside and fined \$50, of which Judge Berry suspended payment of \$25, according to word received here today. Stoner declared he was not satisfied with the verdict, and through his attorney, Arthur H. Honhold, gave notice of appeal. Stoner's case yesterday was tried before a jury of six men.
