as the weather undermined a house at 5346 Calumet Avenue in La Jolla this morning, police said.

"Fallbrook is an island," said the sheriff's spokesman, who added roads all around it were flooded. Access was restored by midmorning, however.

The avocado-growing community of 22,000 was cut off until a route through Bonsal opened at 10:30 a.m., said sheriff's deputy John McBroom. Other roads, including those from Interstate 15, remained closed, he said.

He said the overnight storm dumped more water in the area than storm drains could handle. The sheriff's substation was among the flood-damaged structures early today:

Phone service was knocked out at about 3 a.m.

Fire Capt. Steve Bacon said the storm also disrupted water service throughout the southern portion of
