

DE LUZ LIKELY TO WIN MEMBERSHIP HONORS

DE LUZ, Nov. 9.—First honors in membership in the Chamber of Commerce of Northern San Diego County, proportionate to the population, now held by the town of Carlsbad, where Judge Alex. Bellar secured a registration of eighty-five, may go to De Luz, whose postmaster, L. J. Garnsey, has forwarded to Secretary J. H. Heath a list of eighteen new members, making twenty-three for the community, all of whose dues are paid a year ahead.

Recently a meeting called for the De Luz schoolhouse in the interest of a good road through the canyon connecting with the inland county highway road at Murietta and the state highway at Oceanside, was attended by four of the officials of the northern chamber, whose aid in the road building enterprise has been pledged. Writing to Secretary Heath, Mr. Garnsey says:

"After the nice meeting the people of De Luz were very anxious to join with the chamber in helping to build up the northern part of San Diego county. I think it speaks well for a community when practically all of its citizens join an organization like yours, as well as being a compliment to the organization. A membership of twenty-three from a small community like De Luz shows that we are all working for a better community and a better county."

The people of De Luz have selected C. D. Hegerman to represent the locality on the board of directors of the northern chamber.
