TO OPEN LAND FOR HOMESTEAD ENTRY HERE

Five sections of government land, totaling 2800 acres, in the northwest portion of the county near De Luz, will be available for homesteading for 91 days beginning Feb. 25, 1931, the department of the interior announced today. War veterans will have preference.

Applications may be presented for a period of 20 days prior to the opening date, or from Feb. 5 to 24, inclusive. All applications so presented will be treated as filed simultaneously at 9 a.m., Feb. 25, Louis Vanderhook, acting registrar, stated. Subsequent applications will be disposed of in the order of filing, it was said.

At 9 a.m., May 27, 1931, any of the land remaining unreserved and unappropriated will become subject to entry under any applicable public land law by the public generally.

Sections 13, 24, 25, 34 and 35 only will be available for entry, the remainder lying in Cleveland national forest, except section 36, a school section belonging to the state. Inquiries should be addressed to U. S. Land Office, Los Angeles.
