

DE LUZ HOT SPRINGS.

A Well-Known San Diegoan Buys the Ranch and Will Open a Hotel.

Within a week D. S. Lacey of Lacey, Cofer & Co. has purchased the 120-acre ranch of Daniel Fairbanks at De Luz, which contains the famous hot springs of that region, similar to the hot springs at Elsinore and at Murrieta. Mr. Fairbanks had just completed a hotel which he was about to open to make a resort of the valley. The new owner, however, will open the hotel and a general store as well, where he will be in position to buy up hay, grain, honey and produce for his San Diego firm. The bathing facilities will be made more satisfactory, new houses being contemplated. De Luz station is in the Temecula canyon, about fifty-five miles by rail from San Diego, but the settlement is fully five miles north, in a beautiful valley. Mr. Lacey takes possession of his property this week, and will be followed shortly by his family.
