

De Luz, in the northernmost corner of the county, just above Santa Margarita ranch, is the nearest community to the coast in southern California in which five-acre tracts of government land are being made available to citizens for recreational use, Charles H. Reed, secretary-engineer of San Diego county mining bureau, announced today. Reed said he was being assisted by work projects administration in preparing a survey of tracts throughout the county for the information of the interested public. He said that already he has answered queries from Imperial valley residents, and from persons out of state as far east as Texas, wishing to lease tracts and build cabins. Reed estimated that the county may derive an average of \$14 taxes from improvements which may be assessed in each developed tract.
