

"SMALLEST post office in the world", according to The Guiness Book of World Records, is the original De Luz post office recently restored by Augustine Fredy and Robert George. The post office now at the De Luz Ecology Center was originally built in 1914. De Luz residents, the Norman Criders, donated the post office to the Fallbrook Elementary School District. Credit is due to George and Fredy, who did all the restoration work. George said that they were able to save the windows, doors, and most of the lumber, despite extensive termite damage. Cement was laid and restoration begun three weeks ago by the two generous workers who volunteered their time. The post office will not be put to active use, but will serve as a historical landmark on the school property.
