

# FIVE NEW SCHOOL

## DISTRICTS ASKED

### IN BACK COUNTRY

---

Crowded Condition of Institutions to be Brought to the Supervisors Attention February 8

---

\* Five new applications have been received by the county superintendent of schools for the establishment of new school districts in the back country of the county. The board of education has been establishing new districts whenever the proper application has been made but the communities have grown to such an extent that the buildings are now being taxed to the utmost.

The districts which have requested the erection of buildings are as follows:

De Luz, a portion of Riverside county to be known as Recluse district.

A portion of Wagner, Bernardo, Merton and Miramar.

Another at the head of the bay, embracing a portion of Otay, South San Diego and Highland.

A fourth includes a part of Moosa, Lilac and Valley Center.

The fifth district which asks for a new school house embraces a portion of River, Mt. Fairview and Delpy.

These matters will be brought to the attention of the board of supervisors properly recommended by County Superintendent of Schools H. J. Baldwin at their regular meeting Wednesday, February 8.
