The De Luz people favor the construction of a highway from the northern boundary of the country, a point near Elsinore, thence southward, west of Fallbrook, to De Luz, settlement down the De Luz valley, and thence across the country to a connection with the county highway at or near Bonsal on the San Luis Rey river.
