

# 21 Men Construct Concrete Apron at De Luz Crossing

FALLBROOK, Dec. 1 (Special)—A concrete apron is being constructed at the De Luz road crossing of the Santa Margarita river northwest of Fallbrook by a Works Progress administration crew of 21 men. Apron will be 390 feet long and 18 feet wide, laid on a rock and wire-mesh foundation, protected by a head wall wood-piling driven 4 feet into the river bed.

The project is part of a county-wide program sponsored by the county road department. Unless high water in the river or other obstacles prevent, the river crossing will be completed by Jan. 15. Tentatively included in the project is a suspension foot bridge over the river at the same point. Traffic over the De Luz road and crossing includes U. S. mail car and Fallbrook high school bus.
