CONTROL BY COUNTY, PLEA ON NEW ROAD

The county should act to acquire the right-of-way of the De Luz "high line" road, which serves more than 20 families newly-established along its route, the board of supervisors was advised yesterday by E. I. Kendall, of the district attorney's civil law department. The families have petitioned the county to maintain it, but inasmuch as it was constructed by the state division of forestry last year as a fire trail and never has been taken over by the county as a public road, the road department is without authority to work on it, according to Kendall's information. Complaint that John W. Cole, assistant road commissioner, had in effect ignored a petition made a year ago to remove a traffic hazard at the crossing of Los Angeles drive and Vista way in Vista was made to the board by E. A. Brant, of Breeze Hill ranch. The petitioner stated he showed Cole a pile of earth, left at the crossing after the roads were graded, which obscured the crossing on one side and created an unsafe condition for drivers. He said Cole promised to remove it, but after one year had not acted.
