

DE LUZ SCHOOL DISTRICT GRADUATES

DE LUZ — The 81-year life of the De Luz one-room school district was ended yesterday by a vote of 33-19.

Mrs. Rosalind Martin, teacher, counselor and principal of the one-room school, received the final results late yesterday approving the school's annexation to the Fallbrook Union School District.

It will leave only two one-room schools in the county—Spencer Valley near Julian and Dulzura near Mountain Empire.

The proposal was put on the De Luz ballot after the class load dropped to 10.

Starting in the fall the students will be bussed to Fallbrook grade school classes. Riding along with them will be Mrs. Martin who was hired by the Fallbrook district.

The district was formed in 1887 and the building was put up in 1928. Plans call for the building to be remodeled and preserved as a De Luz community center.
