

# School Bell's Ring to Signal Court Battle

A one-room schoolhouse in De Luz will become a courtroom on April 17 when two San Diego County mountain women go on trial there in a civil suit that charges them with trespassing on the schoolyard.

Defendants are Mrs. Alma F. Click, 93, and her daughter, Miss Veria V. Click. Neighbors describe the daughter, as being in her 70s.

## Unable to Travel Far

De Luz is a mountain community almost 50 miles due north of San Diego.

Superior Court Judge Clarence Harden ordered that the hearing be held in the schoolhouse on the plea of Miss Click, who contended that her aged mother would be unable to travel down the mountains to the county courthouse here.

The suit for damages was brought against the women by the county's De Luz School District.

## Gates Left Unlocked

The school district charges women have trespassed for years across the De Luz schoolyard, leaving gates unlocked and thus allowing people to camp and picnic there on weekends.

The complaint also charges the women with breaking gates and fences and asks for \$100 in damages.

The women have denied the charges.
