

De Luz To Get Telephone Service In 1960

DE LUZ — This remote mountain community will have telephone service in 1960.

C. I. McDonald, a district manager for Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Co., yesterday said construction on telephone lines will begin before Jan. 1. He said survey work is completed and rights of way and easements have been obtained.

Estimated cost of the project is \$75,000. McDonald said 34 persons already have requested service, which will require cables to be run on poles 11 miles from the Fallbrook office.
