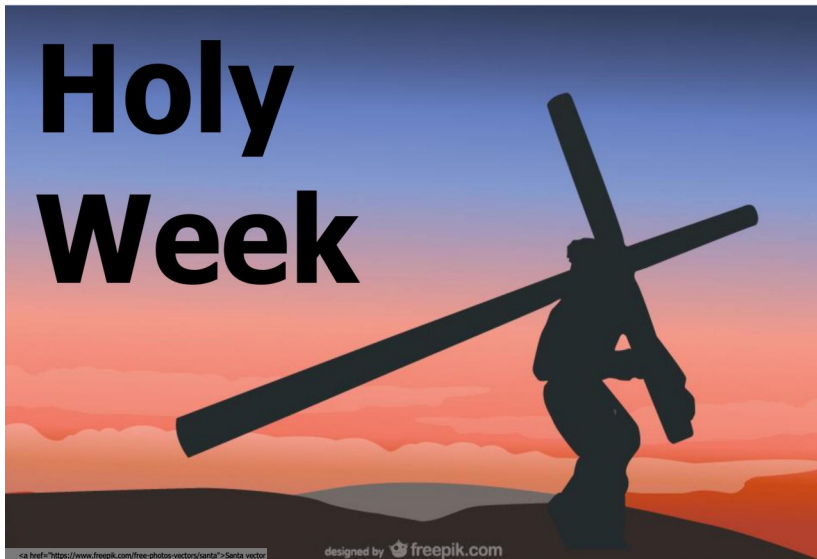

Council Highlights - February 11, 2024

Votes Taken:

- Minutes were unanimously approved
- New Business: Council discussed Easter Offering for 2024. David Yoder made a motion for the offering to be set for \$25,000.00 with a 10% tithe. Funds will support Epworth, God's Helping Hands, and the Gamecock Lutheran Ministry. Motion was unanimously approved.
- Congregational Meeting will be held on Sunday, February 18th at 10:15am in the Assembly Room to vote on Roof Replacement.

Council will meet with Mitzie Shafer and members from the Strategic Planning Committee to go over the proposed Mission, Vision, Core Values, and Key Ministry Objectives virtually on Sunday February 18th at 6pm. A link will be emailed out to everyone to join the call.

Pastoral Ponderings

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...” Matthew 28:19

It has gone by many different names like “The Great Commission” or “Church Evangelism.” It has been carried out in a variety of different ways, using a multitude of different strategies, and employing different methods from simply asking friends to come to church, all the way to t-shirt giveaways. Some churches and denominations are better at this than others, some churches spend larger parts of their budgets on this than others, and some churches are more aggressive in their approach to this than others. However, every one of us are called to do it, every one of us are called to speak up and speak out, and every one of us are called to engage it. Yet, no matter what you call it, how you approach it, the strategies you employ, or the ways you carry it out, “Church Marketing” is hard, scary, and very intimidating.

In this new digital age, we live in, one way to spread the Word of God, lift up the presence of your church, and reach literally millions of people around the globe is through online worship, digital communication, and virtual gatherings. While we gather a select group of people in person on any given Sunday, we gather far greater numbers online throughout the week. For the last four to five years, we have been recording and airing live worship services weekly. Many people who would not darken the door of any church near them have plugged into worshipping with us and coming to know God’s love for them, through you. While significantly less now than during COVID, our online services still gather hundreds of people every week, and provide a virtual community of family to a great number that we will never meet otherwise.

Up until now, 99% of our virtual ministry has been done by Pam Hoskins. I lift up her and her deep commitment to this ministry, and thank her for giving her all to this vital ministry of Mt Tabor. Looking forward into the future, we would like to widen and deepen our online presence and also give Pam the much needed help that she might need to take the next step in virtual ministry. Many of you reading this have great gifts in IT, but you don’t need a degree in tech to be of good use to this ministry. An open heart and a willingness to help is all you need. If this type of ministry is something you are interested in, please let Pastor Wade or Pam know, and we can start plugging you in very quickly. This is not an every Sunday job, but one you can aid in, whenever you have time. Maybe you have watched us on TV, or listened to us on your phone while traveling, and you have ideas to help make it better. We would love to hear them.

Throughout the years, evangelism continues to evolve, but the message of love and grace from God never changes. How we do it does. Come be a part of spreading the gospel, come help us broadcast this message to millions. Help us spread the kingdom of God. Amen. ~ Pastor Wade

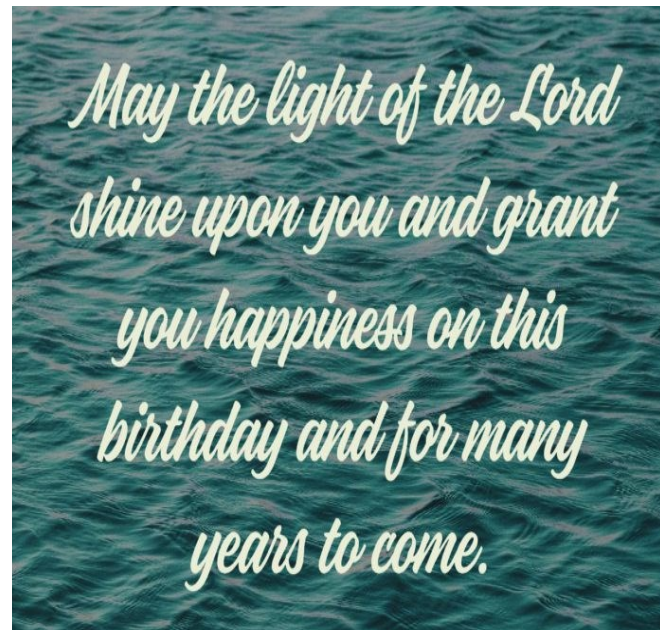

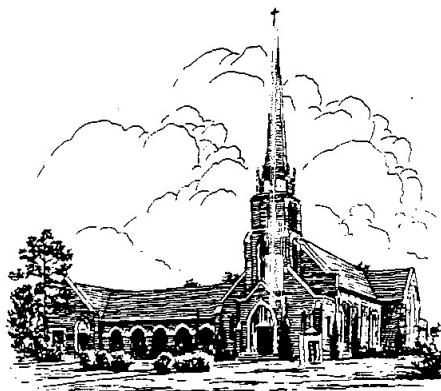
