## **ORDINANCE NO. 879**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 512 ESTABLISHING AN OCCUPATION TAX ON RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGE

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Sedan, Kansas:

- Section 1. Ordinance No. 512 is hereby amended to read as set forth hereafter in its entirety.
- Section 2. There is hereby levied a biennial occupation tax in the amount of \$600.00 on each retailer in the City of Sedan which sells alcoholic liquor in the original package for consumption off premises who has been issued a license by the State of Kansas. The occupation tax shall be paid to the City of Sedan before business is begun under the state license, or within fifteen days after any renewal of the state license.
- Section 3. The holder of a license issued by the State of Kansas for retail sale of alcoholic liquors in the original package shall present such license to the City when making payment of the occupation tax levied hereunder. Upon payment of the occupation tax, the licensee shall be issued a receipt by the City Clerk.
- Section 4. Every licensee shall cause the occupation tax receipt issued by the City to be placed in plain view next to or below the license issued by the State of Kansas in a conspicuous place in the licensee's place of business.
- Section 5. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than \$100.00 for each day's violation.
- Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official City newspaper.
