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JOINING AN AHF COMMITTEE IS A WAY TO MEET NEW PEOPLE AND BUILD LONG-LASTING FRIENDSHIPS WITH OTHERS WHO HAVE COMMON INTERESTS. FOLLOWING ARE THE AHF STANDING COMMITTEES:

- <u>Annual Meeting Committee</u>: is responsible for the planning and coordinating of the Annual Dinner and providing refreshments for the Annual Meeting.
- <u>Budget and Finance Committee</u> : makes recommendations concerning financing and expenditures to the Board; ensures expenditures comply with the by-laws and annual budget; keep a record of the monthly finances through budget comparison; holds a Budget Hearing in October per Section VII-C; and in January presents to the Board, the names of at least two (2) eligible AHF members to serve as the Auditing Committee.
- <u>Building and Grounds Committee</u>: is responsible for recommendation and implementation of the care, maintenance and beautification of all structures and their immediate grounds except for the swimming pool, its supporting structures, equipment, and the immediate surrounding grounds.
- <u>Codification Committee</u>: prepares and maintain an index of all continuing motions of the Board of Trustees or Membership Meetings.
- <u>Community Garden</u>: is responsible for the care, maintenance, and plantings of the community garden.
- <u>Credentials Committee</u>: determines the eligibility of those voting, based on information from the Treasurer or authorized representative. See Section II-C (1). A member of the Credentials Committee cannot be a member of the Tellers Committee or a Trustee.
- <u>Deerhead Hammock Memorial Committee</u>: is responsible for the care and maintenance of Deerhead Hammock and oversee approved events/activities to be held therein. The Committee may receive gifts and donations to be applied to the maintenance of Deerhead Hammock.
- <u>Education Committee</u>: develops, encourages, and implements educational programs for all age groups.

- <u>Erna Nixon Hammock Committee</u>: is entrusted with the care and preservation of the Erna Nixon Hammock and may receive gifts and donations to be applied to its maintenance.
- <u>House Committee</u>: is responsible for housekeeping of the kitchen in the AHF Hall.
- <u>Information Committee</u>: is responsible for gathering, editing, publishing, and distributing such information about the AHF and AHFrelated affairs as may be of interest to the membership.
- <u>Membership Committee</u>: meets AHF applicants to provide information on the history, privileges, and responsibilities of AHF membership.
- <u>Memory Garden Committee</u>: is responsible for the care and maintenance of Memory Garden.
- <u>Nominating Committee</u> is responsible for the preparation of slates of candidates for the Board of Trustees and committees.
- <u>Nutting-Wood Green Committee</u>: is responsible for the care, maintenance, and restoration of the meadow.
- <u>Parks and Paths Committee</u>: is responsible for the care and maintenance of all parks and paths except those already maintained by another committee.
- <u>Recreation Committee</u>: promotes, plans, and conducts special events, entertainment, and recreational activities for all age groups.
- <u>Swimming Pool Committee</u>: is responsible for overseeing the operation, maintenance, and rules of the pool and within the fenced pool area.
- <u>Tellers Committee</u>: is responsible for tallying of any voting by ballot. Members of the Tellers Committee may not be a member of the Credential Committee, nor shall they serve on the Board of Trustees
